THEMATIC SUSPENDED GARDENS

Mah Sing recognised by Malaysia Book of Records

M CITY, one of the iconic developments by Mah Sing Group Bhd, has received a recognition from the Malaysia Book of Records for housing the "First Multi-Level Thematic Suspended Gardens in Malaysia".

The gardens are defined by a variation of themes such as Lagoon Park at Level 7, Bamboo Groove at Level 11, Spring Park at Level 17, Altitude Sky Club at Level 23, Tropical Sanctuary at Level 29 and Sky Garden at Level 35 rooftop.

Each of the suspended gardens was designed to follow a unique theme, which is part of M City's garden city living concept. All the gardens have their own unique ambience which offers leisure alternatives to residents with various preferences.

For instance, Lagoon Park is a landscape podium dominated by an impressive reflecting pool which meanders across the entire podium. The reflecting pools hug around garden spaces and apartment balconies, creating an urban sanctuary of serenity.

The Bamboo Grove was designed as a meditative space inspired by Japanese Zen garden, while Spring Park features a stream that flows through Sky Garden.

Altitude Sky Club houses a 25-metre lap pool and a 15-metre lounge pool. Connecting to the pool area is Sky Garden.

Tropical Sanctuary, finished with timber decking on the 29th floor, features forest trees.

"When we first came up with the concept of garden city living for M City few

years back, we envisioned to personify the residents' living experience with the unique touch of each thematic garden. We felt honoured to be verified by the Malaysia Book of Records for being the first in Malaysia to develop such multi-level thematic suspended gardens," said Mah Sing chief executive officer Datuk Ho Hong Sang.

Located at the corner of Jalan Ampang, M City is a freehold integrated development spanning 2.02ha of land and has a gross development value of RM1.6 billion.

It comprises three towers with a total of 1,585 units, made up of boutique retail shops, small-office-home-offices, serviced apartments and Sky Residences.
